UPDATED VISITOR POLICY IN EFFECT

1 DESIGNATED VISITOR WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS FOR THE DURATION OF A NON-COVID PATIENT'S STAY:

- Inpatient Nursing Units
- Intensive Care Unit
- Emergency Department*
- Procedural Care Unit

** Pediatric patients ages 17 and under in the Emergency Department are allowed 2 designated visitors.*

LABOR/DELIVERY UNIT, NEWBORN NURSERY AND PEDIATRIC UNITS

Patients in PEDIATRICS, LABOR AND DELIVERY and the NEWBORN NURSERY may have **2 designated visitors** throughout the duration of a patient's stay.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

1 designated visitor is permitted during a patient's outpatient testing or procedure. If the patient is admitted to the hospital, **1 designated visitor** will be permitted for the duration of the patient's stay.

Permitted visitors must screen negative and remain masked AT ALL TIMES. Visitors under the age of 16 years are not permitted.

YOU MUST WEAR A MASK

Mandatory Masking

Everyone coming into the hospital and/or hospital areas must mask at all times. You are encouraged to bring your own face mask (surgical/cloth). If you do not have a mask, we will provide one. Visitors will be required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth upon entry and **keep it on at all times while at the hospital without exception.** This is to protect our patients, staff and visitors.
